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4.9 Reverse Buy - Drug Inventory

The purpose of initial laboratory involvement is to assist in establishing an identity for each item in the Michigan State Police reverse buy drug inventory. As such, each item shall have its own unique documentation (i.e., weight, content analysis, laboratory and analyst identifiers, and item number).

Laboratory involvement shall be restricted to verifying the controlled substance identity, weight, and seal integrity of the submitted items. Quantitative analysis will generally not be done, but the final decision is left to the discretion of the Laboratory Director (in consultation with the Controlled Substances Unit Supervisor if necessary).

4.9.1

The laboratory will not determine whether any deleterious substances are present in any material to be used in a reverse buy.

4.9.2

An item of inventory that has been used in a reverse buy shall be resubmitted to the laboratory as a new case. This item shall receive a new laboratory number and be submitted as any other case with appropriate documentation of weight and content.

4.9.3

Laboratory personnel shall not provide drug materials, or perform chemical or physical conversions, to anyone for the purpose of establishing a reverse buy drug inventory.
