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## 19.1 Overview

Evidence handling shall conform to FSD Laboratory Operations Manual Section 4. Evidence discovered to be improperly properly sealed shall be remediated immediately.

## 19.2 Marking QD evidence

QD evidence being forwarded to the latent print unit for chemical processing should be marked with pencil instead of writing ink.

## 19.3 Reception of Evidence Suspected of Containing a Biological Agent:
