8.4 Stereomicroscope

Stereomicroscope = 3-dimensional microscope: a microscope with two optically separate eyepieces to make viewed objects look three-dimensional and giving an upright image

The stereomicroscope (or stereoscope) is utilized to examine all types of trace evidence, with various lighting options.
